Return to School Safety Plan 2021-2022

- We will hold a traditional school day (7:40-2:05).
- All students and staff will be required to wear masks at all times while on buses. Students will be able to share bus seats when necessary.
- All students and staff, regardless of vaccination status will be required to mask while inside the building. The Medway School Board will revisit this each month.
- Students will be socially distanced to the greatest extent possible without disrupting education.
- Physical education classes will be able to share equipment.
- Lunch will take place in the cafeteria. A portion of the gym may be utilized if necessary for social distancing.
- We will not do temperature checks upon arrival, but all families are reminded that students exhibiting symptoms should be kept home from school.
- Visitors during the school day will be with prior approval of building administration.
- Hand washing and social distancing will continue to be prioritized.
- Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be available to all students and staff at all times.
- When a positive case is confirmed the school nurse and building administrator will be responsible for determining the quarantine of students and staff in accordance with the Maine DOE and Maine CDC.
- Pool testing will be implemented. A letter with more information will be sent out early next week.
- Remote learning is not an option this year. However, students who are mandated to quarantine will continue to receive education during their quarantine period.
