MEDWAY SCHOOL BOARD POLICY "POLICY FOR STUDENTS WITH BEE-STING KITS"

NEPN/NSBA CODE:

- 1. Appropriate school personnel will be made aware of the student's condition (in-service for staff by school nurse--those attending please sign attendance sheet).
- 2. Medication as provided by the parent will be kept in a pre-determined place at that school, and all personnel involved with the child will know its location.
- 3. A clear emergency procedure will be outlined on the child's health record. All teachers will be informed of the procedure.
- 4. At least two staff members at that school will be instructed in the administration of said medication.
- 5. "Permission to administer medication at school" form to be signed by both parent and physician.
- 6. The student will be required to wear a medic-alert emblem indicating his/her condition. This is the responsibility of the parent.
- 7. Epipen of Epipen, Jr., Bee-Sting Kit recommended for school use, as this can be self-administered, or easily instructed. School nurse to discuss this with physician if another type of kit has been prescribed.
